CAST ACCESSORY SWITCH BLOCK FOR 1" CRUISER BARS

TOOLS NEEDED:

3MM ALLEN WRENCH

**NEEDLE NOSE PLIERS** 

- WITH A 3MM ALLEN WRENCH REMOVE THE TWO SCREWS HOLDING THE SWITCHBOX TOGETHER, SEPARATING THE FRONT AND BACK CLAMP HALVES.
- 2. PLACE SWITCH BOX OVER THE LEFT OR RIGHT SIDE HANDLEBARS FACING OUTWARDS TO COVER THE RESERVOIR CLAMP. ONCE ORIENTED TO YOUR PREFERRED POSITION TIGHTEN THE TWO SCREWS REMOVED IN STEP #1 WITH A 3MM ALLEN WRENCH.
- 3. REMOVE THE DRIVER SEAT.
- 4. ROUTE THE WIRES FROM ACCESSORY SWITCH BOX ALONG THE HANDLEBAR, UNDER THE NECK COVER IF APPLICABLE, UNDER THE GAS TANK, AND FINALLY UNDER THE SEAT.
- 5. CONNECT THE RED WIRE TO THE ACCESSORY BLOCK OR KEYED POWER (SUCH AS A RUNNING LIGHT). THESE ACCESSORIES WILL ONLY BE ON WHEN THE KEY IS ON.
- 6. CONNECT THE BLACK WIRE WITH THE RING TERMINAL TO THE NEGATIVE BATTERY POST OR THE MOTORCYCLE CHASSIS.
- 7. CONNECT EITHER THE WHITE OR BLUE WIRE TO THE ACCESSORY THE SWITCH IS BEING USED FOR.

NOTE: THIS SWITCH BLOCK IS RATED FOR A 2 AMP MAXIMUM CURRENT DRAW. IF INTENDED USE, SUCH AS DRIVING LIGHT OPERATION, WILL DRAW MORE THAN 2 AMPS, A RELAY SHOULD BE INSTALLED, AS SHOWN BELOW; UNLESS USING BIG BIKE PARTS® DRIVING LIGHTS, WHICH COME WITH A RELAY ALREADY INSTALLED.
