STEP 1

FEATURES

- UV-rated weather-resistant textile material
- Reflective rain cover, and its own stowaway pocket
- Glove friendly zipper pulls
- External adjustable bungee storage system for coat, bedroll or other items
- Low-profile MOLLE for small accessory attachments
- External quick stash pockets, including two bottle pockets



If fastening the bag directly onto the surface of the bike, apply the **SUGGESTIONS** provided clear plastic film to the painted surface. Be sure to fully clean the surface of the bike, and allow to dry, before applying the film.

> Using at least four (4) of the adjustable straps included, secure the bag to either a luggage rack, passenger seat base, rear fender, or an additional luggage bag.

Use the D-Rings mounted to the bag to secure the bag to desired mounting locations. Do not secure mounting straps to moving components such as the swingarm, secure it to stationary objects only.

"Pre-load" the straps by applying downward force (without deforming the bag) as the straps are tightened.



VERIFY THE BAG IS SECURELY ATTACHED BEFORE OPERATING THE MOTORCYCLE. SECURE ALL STRAPS AWAY FROM PAINTED SURFACES, MOVING PARTS, PINCH POINTS OR HEAT. CHECK THE STRAPS BEFORE EACH RIDE AND AT EACH STOP. BAG CONTENTS MAY SHIFT DURING OPERATION WHICH CAN RESULT IN LOOSE STRAPS. ROLL UP ANY EXCESS LENGTH IN ANY OF THE STRAPS, AND SECURE IT TO THE TAUGHT STRAP USING THE ATTACHED HOOK AND LOOP STRAP.
