- M8 x 25mm Socket Head Cap Screw
- Internal-tooth Lock Washer

Metric hex bit set, metric socket set or combination wrench set, needle nose pliers, snap ring pliers, ft-lbs (Nm) torque wrench, blue loctite

STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.

NOTICE

AVOID DAMAGE TO THE MOTORCYCLE. PROTECT PAINTED SURFACES WITH A SOFT CLOTH OR BLANKET.

STEP 2 Unfasten the floorboard support and rear master cylinder assembly from the bike frame. Carefully remove the whole assembly away from the bike. Set mounting hardware off to the side, it will be reused.

STEP 3 Remove existing cotter pin that is fastening the rear master cylinder piston to the existing brake pedal. Set off to the side, it will not be reused.

STEP 4 Refer to PIC 3. Remove the rear master cylinder piston from the existing break pedal.

STEP 5 Unfasten the rear master cylinder assembly from the floorboard support. Set hardware off to the side, it will be reused.

- STEP 6 Remove the OEM hex head bolt from the brake pedal. This will free the top hook of the spring from the brake pedal. Set hardware aside, it will be reused.
- STEP 7 Refer to PIC 4. Remove existing brake pedal from the floorboard assembly's pivot shaft. Pay attention to the order of hardware that is removed: snap ring, flat washer, and brake pedal. Leave the wave washer on the shaft. Set hardware aside, it will be reused.
- STEP 8 Locate provided Brake Pedal.
- STEP 9 Refer to PIC 5 and 6. Locate the hardware that was removed in Step 7. Be sure the OEM wave washer is on the pivot shaft on the floorboard support. Place the Brake Pedal followed by the flat washer onto the shaft. Secure parts in place with the snap ring.
- **STEP 10** Refer to PIC 5 and 6. Locate the OEM hex head bolt that was removed in Step 6. Apply a small amount of blue loctite to hex bolt. Align the top hook of the spring with the new brake pedal and secure it in place with the OEM bolt.
- **STEP 11** Locate hardware that was removed in Step 5. Apply a small amount of blue loctite to each bolt. Align and fasten the rear master cylinder assembly to the floorboard support. Fully tighten hardware.
- **STEP 12** Locate provided Cotter Pin. Align and place the rear master cylinder's piston onto the boss on the back side of the new brake pedal. Secure piston in place using the Cotter Pin.
- **STEP 13** Refer to PIC 7. Locate the floorboard support mounting hardware that was removed in Step 2. Apply a small amount of blue loctite to each bolt. Align and fasten the floorboard support to the motorcycle. Fully tighten hardware.

TORQUE VALUE FOR FLOORBOARD SUPPORT BOLTS: 35 FT-LBS (47.5 NM)

- **STEP 14** Locate provided Brake Peg, Internal Tooth Lock Washer, and Socket Head Cap Screw.
- Refer to PIC 8. From the inside edge of the brake pedal, thread the **STEP 15** screw all the way through the peg mounting hole. Place the washer onto the screw.
- **STEP 16** Refer to PIC 9 and 10. Thread the Peg onto the Screw; adjust the angle of the Peg. Hold the Peg and tighten the Screw. Fully tighten hardware.
- **STEP 17** Test for proper brake function and inspect for any possible interference. Familiarize yourself with this new location before operating the bike on public roadways.
